

2024-2025 Uniform Guidelines for K5 - 8th Grade

If guidelines are not followed, parents will be contacted to bring a change of clothes before the student can return to class.		
	Attire should be neat, modest, and in good condition.	
General	•Hair must be well-maintained and not cause distractions for the student or teacher and must be above or out of the eyes.	
	•Denim is permitted provided distressing in denim is minimal and below the knee.	
	Hats are not permitted inside the building.	
Uniform	•Uniform shirts must be purchased from one of MRCA's approved vendors.	
Shirts and	•Uniform shirts must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, light blue, white.	
Polos	•Long-sleeved shirts may be worn underneath short-sleeved uniform shirts.	
	•Students must have a navy uniform polo shirt for field trips and/or group class photos.	
Charta	•Items may be purchased from any vendor, including but not limited to our approved vendors.	
Shorts,	•Items must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki.	
Skirts, and	•Denim is permitted provided distressing in denim is minimal and below the knee.

	•Items must be no more than 4 inches from the top of the knee.	
Dresses and	•Jumpers and dresses may be purchased from any vendor.	
Jumpers	 Items must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki. Items must be no more than 4 inches from the top of the knee. 	
	Girls:	
Leggings	•Leggings of any color, pattern, or design may be worn underneath skirts, shorts, dresses, or jumpers.	
	•Leggings must not be worn on their own in the place of shorts or pants.	
	Boys:	
	•Athletic leggings of any color, pattern, or design may be worn under dress code-length shorts.	
	Pants may be purchased from any vendor including, but not limited to, our three approved vendors.	
Pants	•Pants must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki.	
	•Denim is permitted provided distressing in denim is minimal and below the knee.	
	•Sweatpants, athletic mesh material, and fleece of any color are not approved for everyday uniform wear.	
Spirit Wear	•Spirit wear will be offered for purchase at specific times of the school year.	
	•On Fridays only, students may wear spirit wear shirts, MRCA middle school sports shirts, or other shirts that have been	
	supplied/bought through MRCA such as Band, Student Council, etc.	
	•On special dedicated days set by teachers and/or coaches, students may also wear shirts from student clubs/sports groups.	
	Those days will be communicated to students as they happen throughout the year.	
Outerwear	Inside the building:	
	•Students may wear any jacket, sweatshirt, or sweater that is purchased from one of our approved vendors in approved	
	school colors and embroidered (by one of our uniform vendors) with the MRCA logo.	
	•Students may wear any sweatshirt or outerwear that is sold and/or provided by MRCA. This includes spirit wear	
	sweatshirts, and sweatshirts from MRCA sports or other MRCA extra-curricular clubs.	
	Outside the building:	
	•Outerwear worn only outside the building (during recess, break, or car line) may be from any store or provider, including	
	but not limited to MRCA or an MRCA approved vendor.
