Application Process

1. The following items must be completed and submitted to the Admissions office to complete your child's application file:
 - Application form(s) with the non-refundable application fee(s).
 - Parent Enrollment Agreement read and signed.
 - Computer Use Contract read and signed for K5 through 8th grade students.
 - School Records Release signed for 1st through 8th grade students.
 - Copy of birth certificate for ALL students.
 - Copies of child's most recent report cards, standardized test scores, and any other special testing your child has ever had for any reason.
 - Teacher Reference Letter given to a current teacher and/or principal for them to complete and mail, fax or email to MRCA.
 - Pastor's Reference Letter.
 - Medical Report must be completed and signed by BOTH the parent AND the physician. If you are unable to secure a physician's signature before turning in the application, please complete your portion of the Medical Report, make a copy of the Medical Report and submit the copy with the application. You may then take the original copy to your child's physician to be completed in a timely manner.
 - South Carolina Certificate of Immunization for ALL students. (This must be on file at MRCA no later than the 30th day of school or your child will be excluded from school until the form is submitted to the office.)
2. Upon receipt of the forms and fee(s) listed above, you will be contacted regarding a meeting with the Admissions Director. The following will be discussed at the meeting:
 - A parent's brief testimony of their personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
 - Child's school records.
 - Entrance testing of students entering K4 through 8th grade.
 - Medical Report.
 - A non-refundable enrollment fee will be collected to reserve a space for your child. Notification of acceptance or denial will be given via a phone call and/or a letter after the entrance evaluation and application meeting.
 - For fall enrollments, the one-time non-refundable Family Enrollment Fee is due by June 15; otherwise, this fee is due at the time of enrollment.
 - Any questions you have about MRCA.
3. MRCA exists as a ministry of Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church to provide an excellent education to Christian families whose children are performing on grade level; therefore, admission to MRCA is primarily based on three criteria:
 - At least one parent is a Christian.
 - The prospective student is performing on grade level.
 - The prospective student gives evidence of good conduct and attitude.

A family not meeting these criteria may be denied acceptance to MRCA.

PARENT ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT



WE UNDERSTAND that the **mission of Mitchell Road Christian Academy** is to partner with Christian parents to equip children to become ambassadors for Christ through academic excellence and an integrated biblical worldview.

Therefore, at least one parent must be a Christian and must sign that he/she subscribes to the following statement before the child(ren) may be considered for admission.

"I believe that Jesus Christ is the only Savior given to man from God, and that Jesus is, Himself, God. I have personally received Jesus as my Savior and Lord and am committed to raising my children according to the inspired Word of God, the Bible."

WE UNDERSTAND that Mitchell Road Christian Academy (MRCA) will teach that the Bible is the inspired Word of God; that it is without error, and that it is our guide for all areas of human living.

WE UNDERSTAND that our child will be taught that salvation comes only through receiving Jesus Christ as one's Savior, and the children, if they have not already done so, will be encouraged to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior, and to give their lives in total commitment to Him as their Lord, to serve Him as He directs them.

WE UNDERSTAND that MRCA plans to partner with the home by reporting progress of our child and by holding conferences with parents.

WE UNDERSTAND the need for home and school to partner together in encouraging children to follow Christian teachings. We pledge to support the goals and purposes of a Christian education through our attendance at conferences and special meetings.

WE UNDERSTAND that the administration of MRCA understands the academic rigors and expectations of each grade. Therefore, upon completion of the entrance evaluation process MRCA will offer placement in the grade which best meets each applicant's individual needs.

WE UNDERSTAND that children will be encouraged to perform to the best of their ability in academic work and other endeavors.

WE AGREE to accept all rules and regulations of the school and authorize the school to administer such disciplinary measures as may be deemed necessary and proper by the administration. We authorize MRCA to employ Love and Logic discipline as it deems wise and expedient for our child in accordance with the standards the school sets for itself.

WE PLEDGE our cooperation with the faculty and administration of MRCA in upholding the authority of teachers in matters of Christian discipline. If we have any concerns we will take these concerns directly to the person involved. If not resolved, we will then go directly to MRCA's administration according to the Matthew 18 principle as outlined in the Student Handbook.

WE UNDERSTAND that our child's attendance at MRCA is a privilege and not a right. If at any time our child's conduct, academic progress or cooperation with the school's authorities is not in keeping with the school's requirements, regulations and/or Statement of Faith, we understand the Head of School and/or administration reserves the right to expel or suspend our child. Further, we agree that in the event we cannot continue to support MRCA relating to the academic, behavioral or spiritual development of our child, we agree to withdraw our child from MRCA in a quiet and orderly fashion. We understand and accept that if we withdraw or are requested to withdraw our child, no refund of registration fees will be made. Additionally, no tuition refunds will be made for the month in which a student withdraws or is requested to withdraw.

WE UNDERSTAND that if we have re-enrolled our child(ren) for the next school year but then opt to withdraw after February 1st but before November 1st, we will not receive a refund of the re-enrollment fee. The re-enrollment fee is non-refundable and non-transferable, except when contingent on tuition assistance. For a withdrawal November 1st or later (after the school year has begun), we agree to pay a \$500 withdrawal fee except under the circumstances outlined below:

- An out of town family move greater than 30 miles
- MRCA can no longer meet the academic needs of the student
- MRCA can no longer retain a student due to disciplinary reasons

As a parent/guardian, **WE ACCEPT** all regulations of the school as presented in the MRCA Student Handbook (incorporated by reference as fully set forth herein) including the MRCA Statement of Faith and fully support the School Board, administration, and staff in observance of such regulations and doctrine and support the Christian learning environment created by MRCA. We understand that this school is a ministry of Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church.

WE AGREE that if our child has a life threatening allergy we will read, sign, and provide the required number of Epi-Pens and antihistamine stated on the Life Threatening Allergy Parent Agreement Page. We will submit a Mitchell Road Christian Academy Allergy Action Plan completed by my child's allergist every year by July 31.

WE UNDERSTAND that if we have a change of address, phone number, or employment, we will provide MRCA with the updated information in a timely manner. MRCA will not ask for updates on a yearly basis.

WE UNDERSTAND tuition payments do not cover all the costs of operating Mitchell Road Christian Academy; therefore, we, as parents, as we are able, will support MRCA through financial giving, volunteering in various ways, and with our prayer support.

WE UNDERSTAND that the application fee (**non-refundable**) is due at the time of application.

WE AGREE to pay the tuition fee over an eleven-month period beginning July 1 and ending May 1. **July tuition is non-refundable.**

WE AGREE to pay the enrollment fee at the conclusion of the interview. This enrollment fee is **non-refundable.**

WE AGREE to pay the one-time, **non-refundable** Family Enrollment Fee by June 15.

WE UNDERSTAND that enrollment shall renew automatically for each successive academic year until graduation from school unless or until this agreement is terminated by MRCA for academic or behavioral reasons in accordance with the Student Handbook, or official notice of withdrawal is submitted in writing or via email by the parent/guardian and is received in school Admissions office on or before January 31 of the current school year. We understand that we will not be asked to sign another re-enrollment contract for the remainder of my child(ren)'s time at MRCA.

WE UNDERSTAND that each January we will be notified through mail or email of the upcoming year's tuition and any changes to this continuous enrollment agreement. We understand that tuition rates are subject to change and agree to those increases for the duration of our child(ren)'s time at Mitchell Road Christian Academy.

WE UNDERSTAND that the re-enrollment fee will be due by January 31 to ensure a spot for our child for the upcoming school year.

WE UNDERSTAND that if financial aid is needed, we must apply each year through FAST. We understand that financial aid awards are evaluated on a student-by-student basis and we should not assume a financial aid award is guaranteed year after year. We understand that if we are awarded financial aid and it is not sufficient for our tuition needs for the upcoming year, we have ten (10) days from receipt of the offer to cancel re-enrollment without further obligation. The re-enrollment fee will be refunded at that time and our child's space may be given to another applicant. If we wait more than ten (10) days to cancel re-enrollment, we understand that the re-enrollment fee will not be refunded to us.

WE UNDERSTAND that Mitchell Road Christian Academy may use photographs taken during school hours or at school functions in any school publication, webpage, website, promotional marketing materials, advertisement, social media, or other school document or publication **UNLESS we initial** the statement below. This agreement is valid for the duration of our child(ren)'s time at MRCA.

_____ We do **NOT** give Mitchell Road Christian Academy **permission to publish** any photograph or image of our child(ren) in any school web page, website, document, publication, or social media.

WE UNDERSTAND Mitchell Road Christian Academy agrees to accept our child as a student for the school year contingent upon acceptance and payment of all tuition and fees in a timely manner.

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

Mitchell Road Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, athletic and other school-administered programs.

Statement of Faith

The following Statement of Faith for our school is in alignment with the more detailed statement given by the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms, which is the creed of Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church and of our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA).

WE BELIEVE in one sovereign God, eternally existing in three persons: the everlasting Father, His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, and the Holy Spirit, the giver of life; and we believe that God created the heavens and the earth out of nothing by His spoken word, and for His own glory.

WE BELIEVE that God has revealed Himself and His truth in the created order, in the Scriptures, and supremely in Jesus Christ; and that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired by God and inerrant in the original writing, so that they are fully trustworthy and of supreme and final authority in all they say.

WE BELIEVE that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary; and is true God and true man, existing in one person and without sin; and we believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into heaven, and in His present life there for us as Lord of all, high Priest and Advocate.

WE BELIEVE that God directly created Adam and Eve, the historical parents of the entire human race; and that they were created in His own image, distinct from all other living creatures, and in a state of original righteousness.

WE BELIEVE that our first parents sinned by rebelling against God's revealed will and thereby incurred both physical and spiritual death, and that as a result all human beings are born with a sinful nature that leads them to sin in thought, word, and deed.

WE BELIEVE in the existence of Satan, sin, and evil powers, and that all these have been defeated by God in the cross of Christ.

WE BELIEVE that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, according to the Scriptures, as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice, triumphing over all evil; and that all who believe in Him are justified by His shed blood and forgiven of all their sins.

WE BELIEVE that all who receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God and are enabled to offer spiritual worship acceptable to God.

WE BELIEVE that the Holy Spirit indwells and gives life to believers, enables them to understand the Scriptures, empowers them for godly living and equips them for service and witness.

WE BELIEVE that the one, holy, universal Church is the body of Christ and is composed of the communities of Christ's people. The task of Christ's people in this world is to be God's redeemed community, embodying His love by worshiping God with confession, prayer, and praise; by proclaiming the gospel of God's redemptive love through our Lord Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth by word and deed; by caring for all of God's creation and actively seeking the good of everyone, especially the poor and needy.

WE BELIEVE in the blessed hope that Jesus Christ will soon return to this earth, personally, visibly, and unexpectedly, in power and great glory, to gather His elect, to raise the dead, to judge the nations, and to bring His Kingdom to fulfillment.

WE BELIEVE in the bodily resurrection of the just and unjust, the everlasting punishment of the lost, and the everlasting blessedness of the saved.

WE BELIEVE that God has established marriage as an exclusive relationship between one man and one woman and that all intimate sexual activity outside the marriage relationship, whether heterosexual, homosexual, or otherwise, is immoral and therefore sin. We believe that God created the human race male and female and that all conduct with the intent to adopt a gender other than one's birth gender is immoral and therefore sin.

Because God has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between a man, a woman, and Himself, MRCA will only recognize marriages between a biological man and a biological woman.

WE BELIEVE that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life.

The statement of faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs. The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. For purposes of MRCA's faith, doctrine, practice, policy, and discipline, the MRCA School Board is MRCA's first interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application with final interpretive authority resting with the Session of Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church.
