



Life Threatening Allergy Parent Agreement Plan

Mitchell Road Christian Academy is **NOT** Allergen Free or Peanut Free. Therefore, Mitchell Road Christian Academy is **NOT** guaranteeing or warranting that a student will **NOT** be exposed to peanut and/or other food allergies in the school environment, on a field trip, or on school retreats.

As the parent and/or guardian, I agree to the following by July 31st of each school year:

- Provide a Mitchell Road Christian Academy Allergy Action Plan (AAP) from a medical professional regarding the specific allergen that affects my child. This documentation will include:
 1. The symptoms and the recommended procedures to address the symptoms.
 2. A medical diagnosis of the testing for the allergen as well as the severity of the reaction to the allergen.
 3. A current picture of your child.
- Provide at least two (2) EpiPens for my child.
- Provide two (2) bottles of Benadryl or antihistamine of your choice.

Preschool and Elementary students will have an EpiPen located in the lunchroom and in the classroom "Emergency Red Bag". Middle school students will have an EpiPen located in the lunchroom and in the Middle School Office.

If deemed necessary by medical professionals and so indicated on the Mitchell Road Christian Academy Allergy Action Plan (AAP), the student may also keep a third (3) EpiPen with him/her in addition to the two (2) locations listed in the above paragraph. Each EpiPen will be clearly labeled with the student's name and location.
